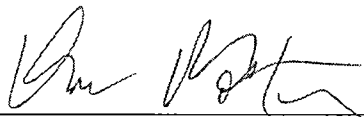
**EMERGENCY EX PARTE MOTION FOR LEAVE TO APPEAR REMOTELY AT THE
AUGUST 18, 2026 HEARING**

Debtor, SHAWN EVANS MARTIN, appearing pro se, respectfully moves this Court for entry of an Order permitting him to appear remotely, by video or telephone, at the hearing scheduled for August 18, 2026. Given that the hearing is scheduled to occur in less than forty-eight (48) hours and will address multiple matters requiring Debtor's participation, Debtor respectfully requests expedited and ex parte consideration of this Motion. Debtor seeks only procedural relief concerning the manner of his appearance and does not seek substantive relief affecting the rights of any other party.

1. Debtor is the debtor in the above-captioned Chapter 7 proceeding.
2. A hearing is presently scheduled before this Court on August 18, 2026.
3. Debtor previously received permission from this Court to appear remotely at prior hearings in this matter and respectfully requests the same accommodation for the August 18, 2026 hearing.
4. Debtor is presently undergoing treatment for Stage IV metastatic urothelial carcinoma.
5. On or about June 17, 2026, Debtor was hospitalized at Cleveland Clinic Florida for approximately thirteen (13) days following a severe adverse reaction to cancer treatment, including a diagnosis of Stevens-Johnson Syndrome, a serious and potentially life-threatening medical condition.
6. Although discharged from the hospital, Debtor remains under active medical care and continues to recover from the effects of both his cancer treatment and the complications resulting from the
